

The Tualatin Valley Community Band is composed of volunteer individuals who have played musical instruments in high school, college, and with other groups. Members range in age from 14 to 80. We are currently in our 26th season of celebrating and sharing music with our community.

We have three goals:

- (1) to provide high quality live public music performances for civic and educational functions;
- (2) to provide an opportunity for musicians of all ages and backgrounds to perform music;
- (3) to foster music education by providing individual scholarships and donations to music education programs.

Our members supplement school music programs through charitable and volunteer activities. In a time of school music program cutbacks, we have upgraded school music facilities, tutored student musicians, and provided opportunities for students to perform outside of school.
